Hasina – How she has self employed with the support of our training in tailoring & embroidery:

Hasina is a young woman hailed from a poor Muslim community. She dropped her studies while she was doing her X class due to her family condition. She is living with her sick old parents. She was jobless, living in dire poverty and upset in her life without any skill to earn money for her livelihood. Because of her poverty condition and sick parents, she was unable to marry and lead a happy life. At that point of critical time her married sister was divorced and living with her. One of our staff observed about the family condition and counseled her and guided her to undergo tailoring & embroidery course run by ROPES. She has undergone six months tailoring course in ROPES, bought a sewing machine with the support of government and started doing her stitching work and saree embroidery. Now she is able to earn Rs. 100 to Rs.200 per day. Further her earnings will be improved. Now she is in a plan to expand her business. She is able to support her whole family with her income. She says proudly that ROPES has made her life difference.

ROPES is rendering this type of intervention to give different job oriented skills and help them to start business on their own to stand on their own feet.
